# 'Audible Presence: Lucio Fontana, Yves Klein, Cy Twombly'

A beautiful show of often little-known works by three revered artists, all of whom exaggerated or abused painting to innovative effect. Fontana looks especially strong, with a mini-retrospective that ranges from a biomorphic plaster ceiling decoration designed in 1949 for a private home in Milan to several of his punctured and slashed paintings. Klein is best represented by a rare white sponge painting and an installation involving quantities of his signature eye-searing blue. — ROBERTA SMITH
